Admission will be made on the basis of the entrance test and interview conducted by the university; candidates with NET/SET will be exempted from entrance test.

M. Phil (Management)

Master degree in the concerned / allied subject with 55% marks at Master Degree and 50% marks at Bachelor's Degree Level (SC/ST & girl candidates will get 5% relaxation in Post-Graduation marks, as per rules). The candidates with NET/SET will be exempted from the entrance test.

MBA (with specializations in Marketing, Finance, HR, Banking & Insurance and Tourism & Travel)

- Passed any Bachelor degree of University established by law i.e. B. Com., B.Sc., BA, BCA, BBA, B. Tech, B. Pharma., L.L.B., B. HMCT, etc. or equivalent from a recognized University with a minimum of 50% marks for General Category and 45% for other Category candidates.
- ii. Admissions will be made on the basis of merit of CAT/MAT/XAT/C-MAT/SUET/HPU/HPTUET.
- iii. In case the seats remain vacant after exhausting the Merit of written test, the remaining vacant seats will be filled up on the merit of the qualifying examination i.e. graduation.

Admission will be made on the basis of entrance test conducted by the university; candidates with NET/SET will be however exempted from the entrance test. Candidates with M. Phil. having minimum eligibility as above are also required to qualify the entrance examination.

ii. M. Phil (Physics), M. Phil (Chemistry) & M. Phil (Mathematics)

Eligibility

Master degree in the concerned / allied subject with 55% marks at Master Degree and 50% marks at Bachelor's Degree Level. (SC/ST and girl candidates will get 5% relaxation in Post-Graduation marks, as per rules). Admission will be made on the basis of entrance test conducted by the university; candidates with NET/SET will be, however exempted from the entrance test.

iii. M.Sc. (Chemistry), M.Sc. (Physics) & M.Sc./M.A. (Mathematics)

Eligibility

Bachelor's degree with concern subject as major/main subject, with 50% marks for General Category and 45% marks for other category candidates.

Admission will be made on the basis of merit of HPU/HPTU Entrance test/SUET.

In case the seats remains vacant after exhausting the Merit of written test, the remaining vacant seats will be filled up on the merit of the qualifying examination

iv. B.Sc. Hons (Chemistry) & B.Sc. Hons (Physics)

Eligibility

Passed 10+2 with concerned stream and having obtained 45% marks.
